

Installing Monthly K100/CMS Updates to PAMS

1) Copying the update file to PAMS.

While running the update file (xxxxxxx.dat) through AFCAV, the option to create a PAMS-version update file is provided. This file name will be the same as the .dat file except the extension will specify the source. For example the K100 update will be xxxxxxx.K10, an F16 update will be xxxxxxx.F16, and a LANTIRN update will be xxxxxxx.LAN, etc.

- Copy this file onto a 5-1/4", 360KB DOS-formatted floppy.
- Type Run at the command line and press <return>. Enter the following elements on the form.

Although the update files can reside anywhere in PAMS, we recommend placing them in the <updates> directory.

```
Path
  [Volume]
  [Directory]
  [Default file prefix]
  [Password]
  [Node]
```

```
sys
updates
```

Press <GO>

- Insert the 5-1/4" disk containing xxxxxxx.k10 (or CMS) update file into the floppy disk drive - either [F0] or [F1], whichever works.
- Type **Run** at the command line and press <return>. Enter the following elements on the form. (You can also use the command "MSDOS Read" if it has been added to your command file set.)

```
Run
  Run file
  [Case]
  [Command]
  [Parameter 1]
  [Parameter 2]
```

```
[sys]<sys>msreader.run
xxxxxxx.k10
[F0] (or [F1])
```

Press <GO>

- Follow the prompts and press <RETURN> and <GO> as directed. This will read the update file from the floppy disk and write it directly into the <UPDATES> directory.

2) Running the update.

- Type Run at the command line and press <return>. Enter the following elements on the form.

```
Run
Run file          <pamsapp>K100updt .run
[Case]
[Command]
[Parameter 1]    *
[Parameter 2]    *
```

Press <GO>

**Note: Although not necessary, you can enter the name of the update file (i.e.: 20021130.F16) in Parameter 1 and the printer (i.e.: [spla]) in Parameter 2. Otherwise, the program will prompt you for these.*

If you get the error, "File doesn't exist—Please enter a new one!", enter the directory along with the file name, i.e.: <updates>20021130.F16.

- Follow the on-screen prompts to install the Update. When done, Press <Finish> and <GO> to exit and return to the command prompt.
